SOCWA's pumping distribution to its eleven member municipalities incorporates:


- 7 pump stations to pump from Detroit
- 3-meter stations and 47-meter vaults
- 26 pumps with discharge ranging from 2,850 to 14,000 GPM
- 5 ground storage reservoirs with a total capacity of 29.5 million gallons
- 3 elevated tanks which total 3.0 million gallons capacity
- 50.5 miles of main with diameters from 16-inch to 48-inch.

These stations provide a major connection to Detroit water and pumping stations.

After evaluating the STABILOC locking system and subsequent field installations, Officials from SOCWA determined that the STABILOC was their answer to securing these important installations.
